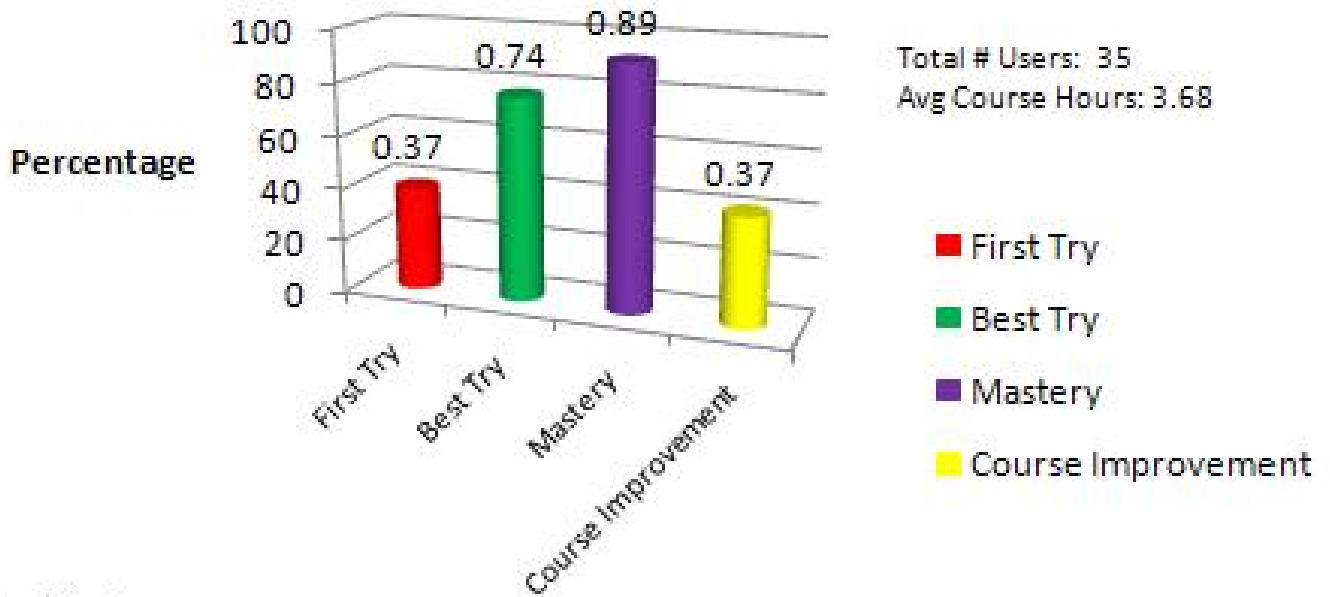


The Collier County Education Group has completed Semester One, 2007 of the CyberLearning Program. This report highlights five of the teachers that are piloting this program.

Michael Garcia is the Business Education Teacher at the PACE Center for Girls. He teaches Business Keyboarding and Business Systems and Technology for Grades 6 to 12. His students work with the School and Office Computing and Web Development Packages. The CyberLearning Group Performance Report (Appendix A) was generated and run to track student progress. As students move through the CyberLearning program they strive for mastery of the course objectives. If they are unable to earn the mastery certificate on their first try they can repeat the course work until they achieve a passing grade. Mr. Garcia's students received an overall 89% mastery and 37% course improvement. Altogether, his students achieved 2290 course work hours with an average of 65.43 hours per student.

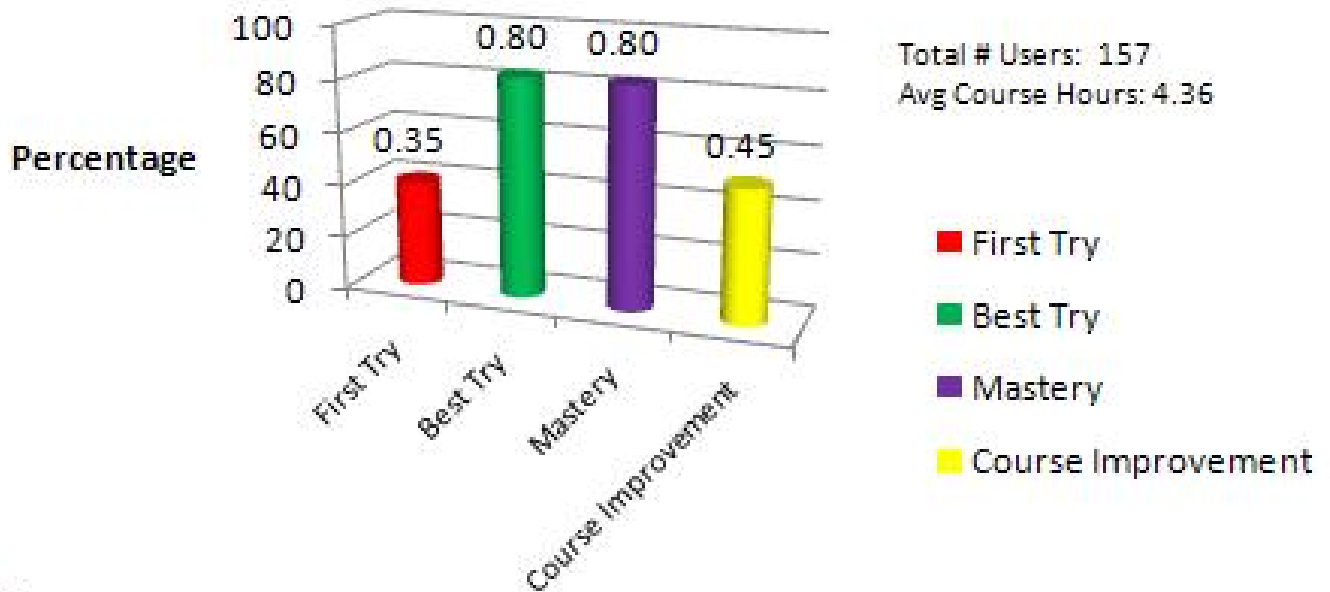

Her students are working with the Web Development Package, concentrating on the Adobe Photoshop CS course work. The CyberLearning Group Performance Report (Appendix B) was generated and run to track student progress. As her students move through the CyberLearning program they strive for mastery of the course objectives. If they are unable to earn the mastery certificate on their first try they can repeat the course work until they achieve a passing grade. Her students averaged 80% Mastery and 45% Course Improvement.

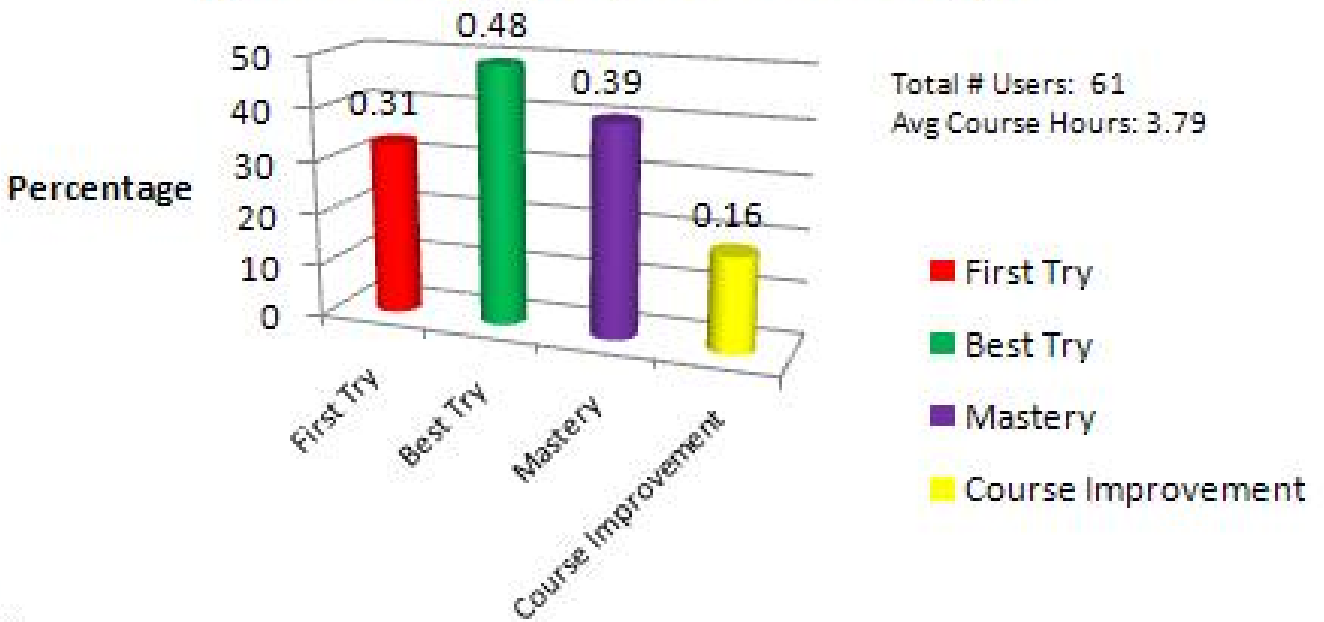

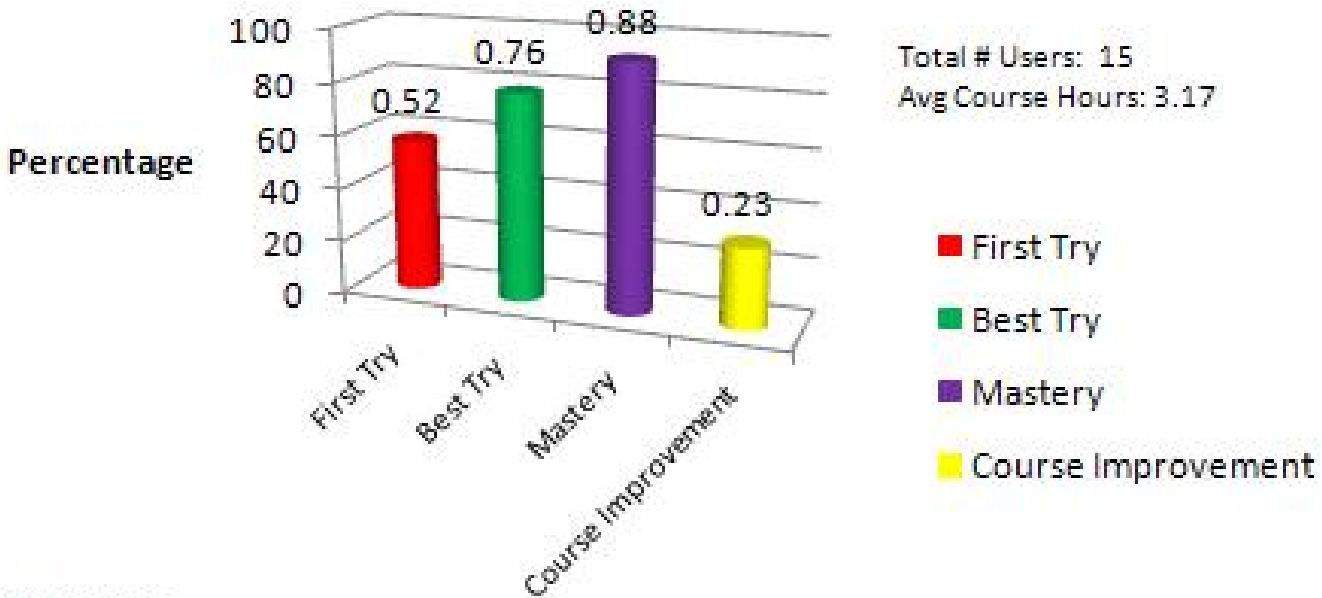

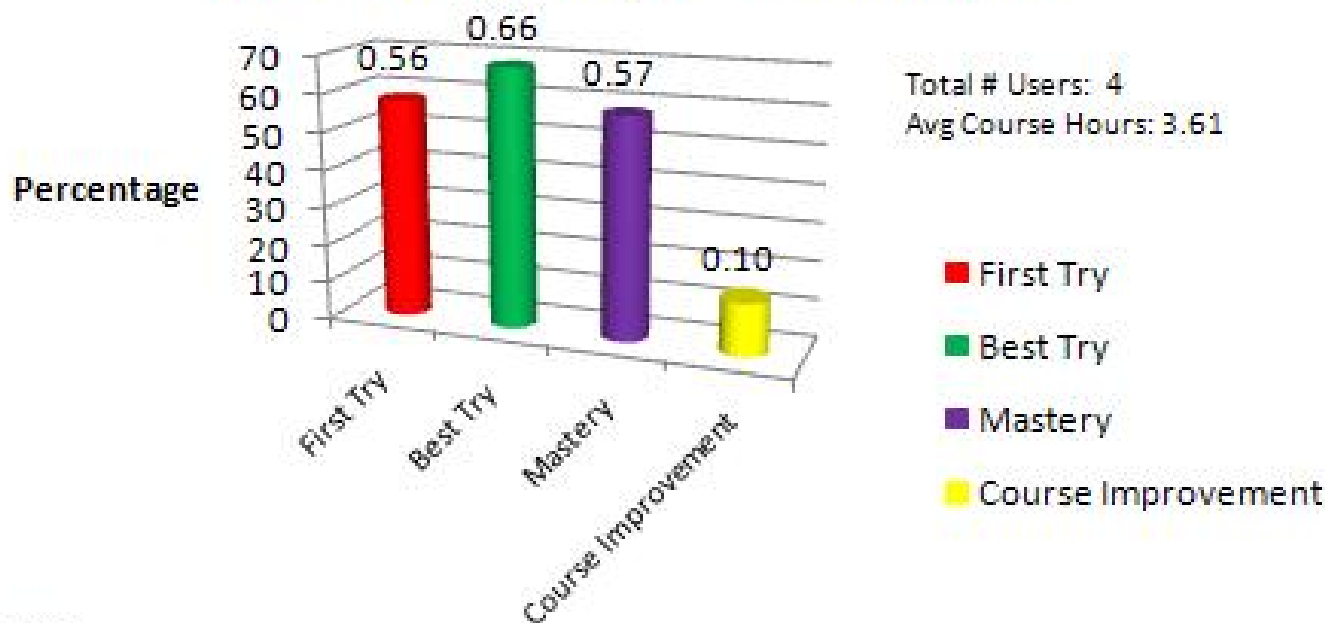
